Foundations of Art: Freshman Magnet Class Summer Work

All summer work assignments are dues on the first day of school. Come prepared with summer work and supplies listed below.

Assignment 1: Observational still life emphasizing basic forms. You will make a pencil drawing of a still life made up of objects in your house that have basic forms to draw from observation. This is not to be drawn from a photograph or copy another still life drawing. You will draw from life.

Criteria:

- Size: Any measurements between 9x12 and 18x24 inches
- Medium: Pencil
- Content: Look for objects that look like <u>spheres</u> (small balls, marbles), <u>cylinders</u> (jar, soda can, bottle, drinking glass), <u>cubes</u> (cereal boxes, plastic boxes that strawberries come in), <u>cone</u> (candle stick holder, waffle cones for ice cream).
 - Choose about 7 objects that are somewhat close in size.
 - Place your objects on a flat surface where they won't be moved.
 - Place some objects close to you and other objects farther away. Overlap some of the objects.
 - Establish a light source by turning on a single light close to your still life.
 - Draw the value changes (dark, light medium grays) on the surface of your objects.
 - Draw cast shadows. Don't be afraid to put in some dark shading if you see it.
 - No outlines define the form with value.

Assignment 2: 30 Day Drawing Challenge. You will use your sketchbook. For 30 days, you will draw the following using any medium you would like. Keep the pages in order, so save a 30-page section – you may use front and back if you like.
